

As we all continue to move forward in this strange time, I urge you to look for ways to continue to connect or re-connect. If you're comfortable and able to gather in person I encourage you to look for ways to plug in and share your gifts and talents by volunteering or joining us for one of the many offerings that we have; sing in the choir, come to Sunday school, decorate a trunk for trunk or treat, volunteer at the clothes closet, serve as an usher or greeter, or pitch in with the facilities crew. If you're not yet able to join us in person pop on for our online bible study, or look for ways you can assist from afar like helping with our Good Samaritan fund phone calls! If you're not sure what to do, give us a call!

This is an exciting season at Trinity as we regroup and grow toward the future. No matter how connected or disconnected you have been or how you feel, it's my prayer that we in the family of Trinity can help one another recognize the truth stated above, that "Even if you are exiled to the ends of the world, from there the LORD your God will gather you, and from there he will bring you back"!
