

This year the Kalamazoo CROP walk is on Sunday, April 30th- hold the date! Walkers will meet at Bronson Park with pre-walk festivities beginning at 1pm. The walk will start at 2 pm and follow an approximately 5K route (with shorter turnoffs available).

Church World Service works in many countries- programs highlighted recently include training women as beekeepers in Nigeria and emergency assistance for displaced Ukrainian people.

<u>Ukrainian Egg Decorating</u> - You are invited on Sunday, **March 26th from 1:30-4:30pm** to decorate Easter Eggs using the Ukrainian (Pysanky) technique. We will meet in the Fellowship Hall. All supplies and instructions will be provided and a free-will offering will be collected for Lutheran World Relief's aid efforts in Ukraine. Pysanky eggs are created using fresh eggs, hot wax, and strong dyes, so please wear old clothes. While the traditional eggs have very intricate details, you are free to design your own creations--no experience needed! This activity is best suited for adults and children ages 8-10 and older since we are using open flames and hot wax. 
