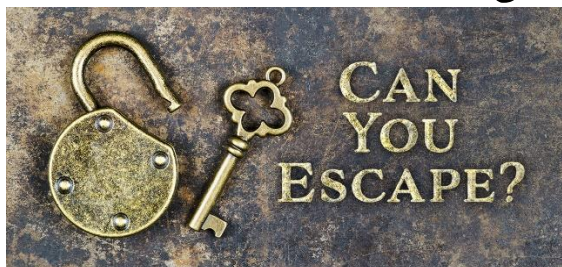

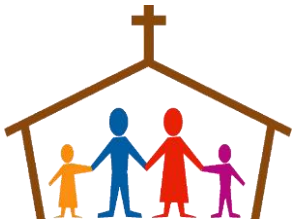
CAMP!!!

Confirmation

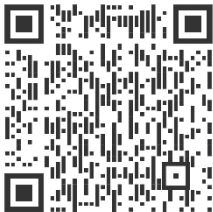
Six of our young people will be confirming their faith on Sunday,

It is with extreme gratitude that I would like to thank the congregation for the 25th anniversary gift! I also would like to thank you for the honor and privilege of serving here at Trinity for the past 25 years. As the hymn states, "Time, like an ever-rolling stream, bears all our years away". The time has certainly flown by quickly. Thank you as well for the support Mary and our family have had for this past quarter of a century.

This was the first time in almost 40 years that I went on "Spring Break" to Florida. Obviously Lent, Holy Week, or Easter often occurs in the last week of March or first week in April, so a trip to Florida these past decades never seemed to work out. When I was younger in the late 60's and 70's, my family would pile in the old station wagon every Spring Break for a trip to Florida.
