Sunday Morning Adult Lenten Bible Study - "We Make the Road by Walking" by Brian McLaren

Lent is traditionally a time of contemplation and renewal as we step back and recenter our focus on the things of importance in our faith and spirituality. To this end, throughout Lent, during Adult Sunday School we will be walking together in conversation with scripture and one another using Brian McLaren's book "We Make the Road by Walking". McLaren is a pastor, teacher, and contemplative who seeks to help us engage with the Bible in a way that opens us to new ways of understanding God's story of Redemption. Join us in the lounge Sundays February 18- March 24 from 9:45-10:35.

First Communion Class Trinity will offer a class for young people who are interested in receiving Holy Communion for the first time. Those completing the class will be recognized during worship and receive communion during the Maundy Thursday service on March 28 at 7pm. 

Lamb... Revelation 5:5-6

I'm sure most people have heard the proverb of how "March comes in like a Lion and goes out like a Lamb". The weather of March can be most capricious. It can be fierce storms at the beginning and warmer at the end, but as we are also most aware in Michigan, the reverse can also be true. The often whimsical and changeable weather patterns can be both frustrating wondrously beautiful. But the inexorable movement from winter to spring carries on no matter what the weather.

In astronomy the positions of constellations in the heavens also change. Leo (a lion) gives way to Aries (a ram or lamb). The very stars and weather patterns are constantly changing before our very eyes and senses. One thing that does not change is the unconditional love and grace of Jesus Christ.

Easter falls on March 31st this year. The Lion of the tribe of Judah and the sacrificial Passover lamb are vivid reminders for us throughout this month of the power, awe, and majesty of our God. May the peace of God which passes all understanding guard our hearts and minds in Christ Jesus – our Lion and Lamb and Redeemer.
